

How to use this CD-ROM

All the documents included on this CD-ROM are in the Acrobat file format and can be viewed using Acrobat Reader. No other software is needed.

The start page has links on the left side leading you to the respective pages which will open with a bookmark column on the left, similar to the one you can see now. These bookmarks allow you to navigate within the respective document and back up in the hierarchy.

The documents themselves use several kinds of links: Links on page numbers link to the respective pages in the current document. Links on names and/or titles link to other documents on the CD-ROM. Underlined blue links or links marked with a grey dashed box will lead you to the respective Internet-sites or they are e-mail address links.

The papers, abstracts and posters presented can be accessed via two paths:

1. under Sessions and Abstracts the presented papers are listed as they appeared in the abstract book. Full papers can be accessed by links on the titles, whereas abstract are linked to the page numbers.
2. under Authors authors are listed alphabetically. Links on names link to the full papers, links on page numbers link to the respective abstracts.

The CD also offers an index function, which allows you to search the CD-ROM, using your own search words. How to use this function is explained under [search](#).

Certainly, the papers can be printed out. The formatting is generally DIN A5, which allows two pages to be printed side by side on one sheet, provided your printer offers such a function.
